

Summer Online Chinese Language Program (Program W)

After careful preparation, the International Cultural Exchange School of Donghua University has launched the Online Chinese Language Program (Program W) for the international students who already have a certain basic proficiency in Chinese. Session 1 has successfully come to an end, and session 2 is about to begin. Now we are glad to announce that ICES is going to launch session 3 and 4 - an upgraded version of the online program!

No matter where you are now located, if you plan to keep a proper learning pace, practice and improve your skills in Chinese listening, speaking, reading and writing, make progress together with the Chinese learners around the world and the teachers from China, experience the grand Chinese culture, you are welcome to join us!

Program Features

- **Real-time Interaction:** unlike the regular offline Chinese language programs, Program W is tailored based on the online teaching modes and features. Two teachers in charge of each class and the teachers will follow up on the learning situation of each student and will adjust the course accordingly to ensure the best learning outcomes.
- **Original Learning Resources:** original course materials are available for download anywhere and anytime. Practical and interesting course contents bring more social opportunities and meanwhile emphasize students' learning experience and a sense of achievement.
- Rich in Culture Experience: a variety of colorful Chinese cultural lectures and cultural activities will be held, and a mysterious cultural package from China will be delivered to you across the ocean. Regardless of the social distance, the cultural experience is still within reach.
- Flexible Schedule: multiple time slots are available. Students can choose one of the time slots according to their time zones and personal schedules.

Study Duration:

- Session 3: June. 22 July. 24, 2020
- Session 4: July. 27 Aug. 28, 2020

Online Course Schedule:

- From Monday to Friday, 3 hours per day, 75 hours per session
- Multiple time slots are available to choose, each time slot is three hours, during which teachers will keep online teaching and interaction. Students can choose to participate in a fixed time slot based on their time zones and their personal schedule. The online teaching schedule is in Beijing time, and the specific starting time will be slightly modified according to the operation of the platform or the network conditions.

Fees (/person):

- Application Fee: CNY 200 (Currently enrolled student: fully waived)
- Tuition: CNY 3000/session (Currently enrolled student : CNY 2800/session)
 CNY 5800/two sessions (Currently enrolled student : CNY 5400/two sessions)
- Payment and Refund: students may audition online first (specific arrangements will be notified later). If the student confirms to participate in the program after the audition, he/she can pay the relevant fees online. The paid fees are non-refundable in any case.

Teaching Plan and Class Levels:

Program W does not accept learners with no basic proficiency in Chinese. Please refer to the descriptions of "Current Chinese Levels" below and evaluate your current Chinese ability and vocabulary objectively to help yourself enter the appropriate class level:
