

I am an international applicant and want to apply for a Bachelor's degree programme with restricted admission (with NC) for the 1st semester.

1. I print out this checklist and make a note of my access data:

Username hochschulstart.de	
Password hochschulstart.de	
Applicant Identification Number (BID)	
Applicant Authentication Number (BAN)	
Login uni-assist (e-mail address)	
Password uni-assist	
Applicant number uni-assist	

2. I start my registration at hochschulstart.de and make a note of the user name and password I have chosen myself.
After completing the registration, I find BID and BAN under "my data".
3. I am applying via hochschulstart.de for my desired degree programme(s) at the Hochschule Niederrhein, University of Applied Sciences (HSNR) and **prioritising** my applications (very important!).

4. I go to the uni-assist portal and register here as well.
I enter the BID and BAN from hochschulstart.de and transfer the data.
I am completing the registration.
Now I can apply in uni-assist for a maximum of three degree programmes at HSNR.
5. After checking my documents, uni-assist forwards my application to the HSNR.
I will automatically receive my access data for my account in the HSNR online portal. I **don't** have to apply again on the HSNR online portal!

6. I check my emails regularly.

A study place offer is visible after the allocation procedures on hochschulstart.de and in the HSNR online portal.

7. I accept the study place offer on hochschulstart.de.

8. I apply for enrolment in the HSNR online portal and send the necessary documents by e-mail.

The study place must be accepted within ten days!

The official admission letter is only uploaded in the online portal of the HSNR.
