

Cultural Education and Cultural Management (M.A.)

a) Widening of knowledge

Students graduating from this course have acquired practical knowledge from the field of cultural education and cultural management, which encompasses, in particular, the specific conditions relating to organisations involved in cultural educational work. They are able to deal with structural and organisational management tasks within local authorities, national and European institutions as well as in the contexts of art promotion and event management.

b) Intensification

Students graduating from this course possess educational, research related, and managerial skills and knowledge from the fields of social sciences, cultural studies management and law, which qualify them to perform key functions in cultural education and art related institutions or which provide them with additional and more advanced skills for successfully dealing with tasks relating to their professional educational and managerial roles.

c) Development of working knowledge and skills

aa) Analytical knowledge and skills

Students graduating from this course are qualified to analyse procedures and problems relating to conceptual, organisational and financial practice within cultural education and cultural work related institutions, to find economic and educational enriching solutions, and consider factors from other disciplines. They possess analytical and organisational skills and are able to apply this knowledge and systematically address new academic problems and the challenges of society using this knowledge.

bb) Systematic knowledge and skills

Students graduating from this course are qualified to analyse and develop interdisciplinary scenarios. The interdisciplinary course enables them to demonstrate social science -, cultural studies -, research, management - and applicable legal skills and to apply these in dealing with cultural educational, empowerment and management challenges in the wide field of institutions and culture related agencies. They are able to think and act in an interdisciplinary and systems-orientated manner.

cc) Communicative knowledge and skills

Students graduating from this course are able to take on management responsibilities in culture related institutions and fields. They are able to manage projects independently, taking into consideration sociological, cultural, educational, economic and legal factors and to produce solutions to problems and further social development. They are able to present and explain current and challenging situations on the basis of academic knowledge to others, including non-academics. They are able to present and explain results orally or in writing.
