## ECO GENDER NEUTRAL PULLOVER

The Team No.10 of faculty Textile and Clothing Technology, created together with STACKS Ehrenfeld a sustainable and gender-neutral Pullover and additionally a label with new performances.

1. Gender-neutrality means the cut of the Pullover was designed to fit both men and women.
2. Functionality is expressed by pockets and the materiality: At his left arm the wearer can find a small pocket perfect for his smartphone. Through a small hole in the pocket the earphones can be guided through to avoid being bothered by the cables. The pocket added to the back is perfect for e.g. keys.
3. Sustainability is guaranteed by: \_The Pullover is mostly made out of TENCEL. A fiber which in production needs around 90% less water than ordinary cotton. \_The collar is Organic Cotton while the yarn is recycled polyester. \_Natulon, consisting out of recycled plastic bottles and fabric leftovers, was used for the zipper. \_The label was offered in two ways made out of artificial leather and in a variation of a mix of environmentally compatible cardboard and latex. \_Both labels were produced sustainable and vegan in Germany.

We are proud to announce that our pullover can be called all together sustainable as well as gender-neutral and fits perfectly to the value of the team STACKS Ehrenfeld: a young enterprise in Cologne where ecologically sustainable and ethically fair clothes are being sold.
