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ReSet

The bench ReSet by Franziska Poddig argues a modular, sustainable upholstery system, AND a sign against mass consumption and for conveying a new (old) value at the same time. This value does not only refer to material aspects, but also to values in human interaction. The upholstery system, consisting of various movable cuboids, alludes to the different cultures in Europe and the world, which are all essential parts of our society. The frame of untreated wood carries the upholstery (movable cubes) which are made from pure wool felt.

The filling of the upholstery is made of 100% old clothes. Using disposed clothes does not only remove parts of the excessive textile production from circulation, but at the same time draws attention to the fact that mankind is currently "sitting" on tons of textile garbage in a figurative sense. The ReSet bench by Franziska Poddig intends not only a critical reflection of one's own consumer behaviour, but also a questioning of the individual contribution to a diverse society:
