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sustainable mobile modern chair - by Sebastian Gondek (in memoriam)

One spends a huge part of his life sitting on countless different chairs. Seating furniture is often only designed for a certain type of use. A chair concept that is flexible and can be used for different parts of life, without sacrificing function or comfort could be an interesting alternative.

Sebastian Gondek illuminated the history of the chair for this student research project. The development of usage habits and modern trends were the trigger for the creation of the chair concept. The concept comprises a chair, that is flexible in its handling, but reduced in its design language, suitable for both indoor and outdoor use and particularly easy to transport thanks to its construction. In order to clarify the concept, a functional prototype has been created on a scale of 1:2.

The use of shaped wood offers flexible and sustainable solutions for manufacturing the basic frame of the chair. The construction allows the chair to be adapted to the respective usage situation or personal design preferences by means of various covers. The concept "sustainable mobile modern chair by Sebastian Gondek" is inspired by the interdisciplinary workshop at Fritz Becker GmbH & Co. KG, in Brakel, to whom we would like to express our sincere thanks.
