

Examination - Rules WS 2020/21 (Corona)

- Students with symptoms such as fever are not allowed to take part in the exams!
- Check your student email account regularly (also immediately before the exam) for last-minute changes.
- You must wear medical masks on the entire campus of the Niederrhein University of Applied Sciences and also during the exam. Medical masks are so-called surgical masks, masks of the FFP2 standard or comparable masks (KN95/N95).
- If you have a medical certificate with a mask exemption, contact the respective coordinator of the exam immediately (in the schedules in the last column) and inform them in advance at least two days before the exam.
- Please fill in the exam header first and the "Record sheet according to the Corona Protection Ordinance", which will be collected when you tick off.
- Hands must be disinfected before entering the examination room (dispensers are available at the entrances).
- As the outer doors of the HS buildings are still closed, it is absolutely necessary to arrive on time. If you are late, you will not be allowed to enter the building! Please allow enough time to check your room number at the D-building and then go to the lecture hall. Entrances:

ZE34-36: side door courtyard to the right of the main entrance

Audimax/Streifenmax: Webschulstraße or car park Webschulstraße

S-Räume: entrance Webschulstraße, S 304 entrance Richard- Wagner-Straße

Seats will be allocated to you.

- It is not possible to leave the room early. All students must remain in their seats until the end.
- After finishing the exam, please put the pencil aside and place the exam upside down on the table 1m next to you. If you continue to write despite being asked to do so, this will be considered an attempt to cheat (see below for consequences).
- Please also avoid gathering outside the buildings and keep the minimum distance to your fellow students.
- You will find the division in which room you are writing on the window panes of BUILDING D, so that you can look it up without entering the building.
- Attempt to cheat:
 - o An attempt at cheating will automatically result in the free attempt for that exam being forfeited and your exam being graded with 5.0.
 - o If you attempt to cheat in the 3rd attempt, you will also definitely forfeit the possibility of taking an oral supplementary examination, which will result in your studies being terminated without a degree by exmatriculation!
