

The funding association of the faculty, the Textile and Fashion Network (TFN), offers in cooperation with the Barbara Laura Lebek Foundation the possibility of scholarships for studies abroad. A selection committee of three professors decides on the award.

Formal Requirements – Selection Criteria – Application Procedure

The Barbara Laura Lebek Foundation is a charitable organization with the aim to promote communication among nations through the international exchange of talented students and, in individual cases, also of lecturers and professors of German and foreign Art-Fashion-Design or Textile Engineering Schools and Colleges.

Formal Requirements- Selection Criteria

The Barbara Laura Lebek Foundation expects applicants to provide outstanding academic achievements as well as the willingness to actively participate in promoting the mutual understanding between the guest and the home country.

Students from the fourth semester or higher can apply. At the time of application, there must be a sufficient number of meaningful performance records.

The maximum age of the students at the time of application is 28 years. In justified cases, however, exceptions may be allowed. Full-time studies are not funded.

Applicants must commit to submit - at the latest 4 weeks after completion of the sponsored study abroad - a detailed report with the focus on international understanding and the knowledge and experience acquired during the studies abroad.

- CV including special interests
- Previous stays abroad and language skills
- A valid passport (copy)

- 30. June for funding in the following WS
