Process

Prospective students are nominated for an exchange stay by their home institution.

To do so, the home institution is required to send an e-mail to inboundexchange@hsnr.de containing the following information: full name | nationality | e-mail address | degree programme at home university | planned degree programme at HSNR | level of study | study period (number of semesters)

We will briefly review the nomination(s) and send a written approval by e-mail, before proceeding with the application process.





Application

Deadline

1st June for the winter semester

1st November for the summer semester

Process

We will provide all nominated students with a link to our online application portal Mobility Online.

Students will initially be required to create a personal account in *Mobility Online*. Subsequently, they will be able to fill in their personal data as well as upload the following documents:

letter of motivation | transcript of records | language certificate | curriculum vitae | portfolio (only applicable to students of our design programmes, not design engineering)

After all documents have been uploaded, we will review them and inform students once the application has been approved.

We reserve the right to reject applications in case they are incomplete or submitted after the deadline.

Language requirements For courses taught in German: B2 (at least B1.2 when applying) For courses taught in English: B2 (at least B1.2 when applying) Please refer to our website for a list of language certificates.

Learning Agreement (LA)

Working with EWP

Erasmus without paper

Students, whose application has been approved, can move on to finalising their LA. In case the sending institution is working with EWP, students fill in their desired courses into the sending institution's online learning agreement. Once the sending institution has approved the course selection, the sending institution informs HSNR. HSNR will match the online application with the respective student's learning

agreement and will notify the relevant HSNR faculty coordinator.

The Learning Agreement will be signed off by both the sending and the receiving institution as well as the student online.

Working without EWP In case your home university is not working with EWP yet, please inform the incoming exchange student advisor on inboundexchange@hsnr.de.





We will subsequently ask students to enter their selected courses in Mobility Online under the tab Learning Agreement.

Once the relevant HSNR's faculty coordinator has approved these courses, students can download the Learning Agreement as a pdf- file from our <u>website</u>, sign it, have it signed by their home university and upload it to Mobility Online.

Acceptance & invitation letters

Acceptance Letter

After approval of the Learning Agreement, HSNR's incoming exchange student advisor will send an Acceptance Letter and further information to each successful candidate. The Acceptance Letter formally confirms the successful completion of the application process.

All our Non-EU students will additionally be provided with an Invitation Letter in order to apply for a student visa.

Enrolment

Enrolment

Upon enrolment you will be able to create your HSNR student e-mail account gain access to all HSNR online services.

Semester contribution

HSNR charges no study fees, but a semester contribution which amounts to 353,30 € (summer semester 2026). It includes payment for a semester ticket for public transportation.

We will inform you about the current amount of the contribution and the relevant bank details after the application process.

Staying for 2 semesters

Students who have been nominated to stay for 2 semesters, simply need to pay the current semester contribution for their second semester in order to re-enrol.

Health insurance

We strongly recommend to take out health insurance in Germany, should students not be covered by the European Health Insurance Card. Please refer to our <u>website</u> for more information.





Accommodation

Halls of residence

HSNR holds a limited amount of places in student halls in Krefeld and Mönchengladbach, which are run by the *Studierendenwerk Düsseldorf*.

We will ask all students if accommodation in student halls is required and – upon the students' replies – will inform the *Studierendenwerk* accordingly.

The HSNR will then provide these students with a link to formally apply for the places. Students will be equired to enter their personal data as well as upload a passport photo and their letter of acceptance.

Once all data has been entered and documents uploaded, the *Studierendenwerk* will send a second link for students to click on in order to activate their application.

Please note that the link can only be activated within 5 days after receiving it.

After that students will be e-mailed an offer for a place in student halls which they then need to accept within a certain period of time.

Once the rental agreement is finalised, please make an appointment with the property manager to pick up your keys upon arrival and be shown to your room.

In case you have not been allocated a room, please see the information on our <u>website</u> to find alternative accommodation.

Please make sure that you contact the <u>exam office</u> right at the beginning of your studies at HSNR to ensure that there have been no alterations to the courses you put down in the Learning Agreement or to the exams you would like to sit.
